Description: Lights, Camera, Action! This is an exciting program that will involve your child in creating morning news broadcast to be shown over our school's short circuit TV system for the rest of the year.

Grade: 4th Grade

Where: Broadcasting Room

When: 7:45 every morning that their team is scheduled to broadcast.

Dates: Students will be divided into broadcasting teams; they will then receive a schedule of when they will be on the news. Students will be able to do safety patrol and lab assistants since we coordinate with each other to schedule their time slot so that they are not doing the other job at the same time.

Semester: All year

Parental Involvement Required: Students will need to be dropped off the mornings of the broadcast at 7:45.

Enrollment Limitations: Depends on the number of students wanting to participate. (10 students per broadcasting team) We try our hardest to make sure everyone that applies gets some type of job.

Registration Procedure: Students will need to apply for their job on the team. The applications will be available the second week of school.

Application forms will be handed out in the classroom to all students expressing an interest in the program and NOT at Volunteer and Club Sign-Up.
